

1. Purpose

The Academic Research Fund Committee is responsible for adjudicating Academic Research Fund applications and granting awards up to the established maximum award values.

2. Membership

- 2.1 The Academic Research Fund Committee is a sub-committee of the Academic Research Committee.
- 2.2 The membership of the Academic Research Fund Committee shall include the following five (5) voting members:
 - (1) Full-time academic faculty member from the Faculty of Business
 - (1) Full-time academic faculty member from the Faculty of Health Disciplines
 - (1) Full-time academic faculty member from the Faculty of Humanities and Social Sciences
 - (1) Full-time academic faculty member from the Faculty of Science and Technology
 - (1) Non-academic staff member with research duties contained within their position description
- 2.3 Committee members normally serve for a three-year term (July 1 to June 30).
- 2.4 Committee member terms are staggered to ensure continuity on the committee.
- 2.5 Committee members are appointed by the Academic Research Committee.
- 2.6 Chair is appointed by the Academic Research Fund Committee members.
- 2.7 Chair may serve a 2-year term in this role.

3. Responsibilities

The Academic Research Fund Committee has the following powers and duties:

- 3.1 Adjudicate Academic Research Fund applications and any other related funding applications and issue awards up to the established maximum award values.
- 3.2 Review and recommend changes and/or updates to the Academic Research Fund Guidelines.
- 3.3 Where the Chair of the Academic Research Fund Committee deems it necessary, a special meeting of the Committee shall be called to deal with urgent matters.

The Research Office shall act as the Secretary to the Academic Research Fund Committee.
